Dear Bryson,

This letter is to notify you of the resolution of two reports I received from MIT Police regarding an incident that occurred on March 11th, 2023 and a follow-up incident that occurred on March 12th, 2023. The first report stated that an officer responded to a noise complaint at Nu Delta and shut down the party. The second report stated that a neighbor found broken glass in their yard, potentially relating to said party. Based on this information, Nu Delta may have violated the following policies:

MIT Mind and Hand Book

II (7). Disorderly Conduct

MIT prohibits disorderly conduct. Disorderly conduct is defined as any unreasonable or reckless conduct by an individual or group that is inherently or potentially unsafe to other persons or to their real or personal property, and/or any behavior that disrupts the peace or interferes with the normal operation of the Institute or Institute-sponsored activities. Disorderly conduct includes making unreasonable noise, disrupting a lawful meeting, obstructing pedestrian or vehicle traffic, or creating a hazardous situation.

After reviewing the police report and your response, I have decided to resolve this case administratively. Based on the information provided, I find Nu Delta responsible for all policy violations. Based on the police reports, there was sufficient noise created to lead to a noise complaint report.

While Nu Delta was found responsible for all policy violations, I am only issuing a warning since Nu Delta cooperated with police and complainants and resolved any complaints. I strongly encourage your chapter to be cognizant of noise and control of event attendees when holding social events in the future.
