3 JUDICIAL COMMITTEE REPORT

- 3.1 CPW fines will be forthcoming for all chapters with infractions.
 - 3.1.1 There was amnesty for all Wednesday night infractions, and all violations on following nights are being fully enforced.
 - Fines are \$5 per ounce for alcohol under 20 proof and \$25 per ounce for higher proof, with fines judged by capacity of containers found, not the volume of contents.
 - 3.1.3 Fines will come out around the end of the week.

 - 3.2.1 If you catch people bringing stuff into your party, confiscate all alcohol and notify us immediately so that we can ensure that inspectors are aware.

- 9.2 Vote to approve constitutional amendment that places IFC Associate Members under the IFC rules.
 - 9.2.1 The vote requires ³/₄ approval-- fifteen or more of the twenty houses present.
 - 9.2.2 The motion passes as worded, and associate members are now to be held to all IFC rules and regulations.
